Code of Ethics

- Members and non-members of Snake River Meat Goat Association (SRMGA) shall at all times conduct themselves with honesty and integrity at all times.
- Behavior in this competitive environment of the goat world shall always reflect the highest standards of honor and dignity at all events, communications and gatherings that promote our commitment to the goat and our association.
- Refrains from a conflict of interest or the perception thereof.
- Refrains from threatening actions and poor language.
- SRMGA does not discriminate on the basis of age, disability, economic status, ethnicity, gender, race, religion, or sexual orientation.
- This code applies to all members and non-members including juniors that attend SRMGA events, discussions, meetings, and use of social media.
- SRMGA is under an affirmative responsibility to do more than avoid improper conduct or questionable acts. Their moral values must be certain and positive so that others will be influenced by our example.
- Members that violate the code of Ethics and demean the integrity of our Association will be dealt with. The actions of the individual will be addressed and sanctions of probation, exclusion at events or gatherings or removal of membership may be imposed.
