This weekend of celebrating the Boer Goat is being brought to you by the **Snake River Meat Goat Association**.

**Both shows are official ABGA shows and ABGA rules shall govern.**

**All animals must be registered with ABGA.** Original registration certificates must be presented at check in for any animal over 3 (three) months of age. Stamped received copies of applications for animals under 3 months will be accepted. All animals must be tattooed and be readable.

Base date for computing age is May 3, 2014 (Saturday show) and May 4, 2014 (Sunday show).

All animals will be health checked prior to unloading. **No animals will be allowed to unload if exhibiting signs of illness, contagious disease, external parasites, sore mouth or abscesses.** Any abscess site must be healed and haired over.

**Please see Youth Jackpot packet for complete rules, information, fees and entry forms regarding the jackpot.**

**Check-in and Arrival Times:** We will begin checking in goats at 1:00 pm on Friday, May 2, 2014. After unloading your animals, please report to the show secretary with your papers to get checked-in. If you are going to be late arriving (after 9:00 pm) please give us a call at (208) 739-0102 or (208) 739-7285, so we can make sure to be there to help you. Goat arrivals will be accepted until 1 hour prior to show time. Arrival and check in the night before the show is recommended.

**Awards:** The ABGA will provide ribbons and rosettes for both shows. Ribbons will be awarded through fifth place. Rosettes and cash award for Grand and Reserve Champions of each Division. Special Awards will be given for Overall Grand and Reserve Champions of each Division.

**Entries:** Fees must accompany entries. **Entries will not be considered received and pens will not be reserved until fees are received.** The early entry deadline is **April 25, 2014 (postmarked)**. Entries and /or substitutions can be made, up to one hour before start of show. Entries received after the April 25, 2014 early entry deadline may not be included in the show program. **Note: Substitutions will be allowed, but no refunds.** Please make checks payable to **SRMGA** and send entry forms and fees to: **Marilyn O'Leary, 2175 SW 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. Fruitland, ID 83619.**

**Early Deadline: April 25, 2014** (postmarked) - **\$10.00 per head per show day**

**Late Entries: April 26, 2014** (postmarked) – **1 hr before show- \$12.00 per head per show day**

**Pen Fees: \$10.00 per pen** (1– 4 animals per pen, depending on size and age) Additional pens needed at check-in may not be available or may be separated from other pens. All pens will be assigned prior to check-in date. If you wish to have a tack pen please include it on the entry form. Pens will be supplied with bedding (straw).

**Youth Jackpot:** Youth Jackpot will take place after the ABGA show on Saturday. The Jackpot is open to all youth up to age 21 and will include classes for Market, Breeding and Showmanship. Please see Youth Jackpot packet for complete rules, information and entry forms.

**Meals:** Friday night we will have a potluck dinner for all exhibitors. Saturday & Sunday we will take a one hour lunch break so everyone has time to get something to eat. Denim~n~Dust 4-H club will have concessions on the fairgrounds Saturday and Sunday. We will have snacks and drinks available for show participants.
