

Treasure Valley Classic Youth Fitting and Showing Seminar

at the Owhyee County Fairgrounds
N 5th St W and Rodeo Rd, Homedale, Idaho

Each Youth wishing to participate will need to bring one goat. There will be no age requirement for the goat and it can be either a wether or doe. The goats need to be washed and dried and ready for clipping by 9 am. All of the participants will need to bring their own stands, clippers, and other necessary equipment so we can have all the participants doing the same thing at the same time. If equipment has to be shared, participants will have to take turns, so that everyone gets a chance. At the beginning Maddie will have both a breeding doe, and a wether on stands, and she'll demonstrate fitting on both of them. The participants can bring either a wether or a doe, whichever is their preference, and they will be helped with either one. We should be able to break for lunch for about a half hour around 1 pm. Lunch items will be available for purchase.

For the showing demonstrations after lunch, wether showing and breeding doe showing will be done separately. Participants with just breeding stock or just wethers will have to wait while the demonstration is being done with their counter-part.

If the participants in the Fitting and Showing Seminar are planning to show their goats the next day, there will be pens available to hold the animals overnight. However, you will have to provide your own bedding and pens MUST be cleaned on Sunday after use. Also, to insure enough electrical power is available for all participants, if you have a generator, please bring it.
