Both shows are Official IBGA Shows and IBGA rules shall govern. Market animals will be shown by weight. Market goats are required to have a complete unbroken mouth (no teeth missing) and kid teeth. The judge will make the determination. Any legal or illegal substance that alters the conformation or enhances the natural appearance of the animal is not permitted. All goats may be subject to random drug testing and/or veterinary examination. Horns are optional, but must be tipped. All males must be castrated (banded or surgically removed, clamping is not allowed), with testicular and scrotal tissue removed. All animals should be sheared from knees/hocks up.

All animals must be registered with one of the recognized Boer goat registries. Original registration certificates must be presented at check in for any animal over 3 (three) months of age. Stamped received copies of applications for animals under 3 months accepted. All animals must be tattooed and be readable.

Base date for computing age is June 23, 2012 (Saturday show) and June 24, 2012 (Sunday show)

All animals will be health checked prior to unloading. **No animals will be allowed to unload if exhibiting signs of illness, contagious disease, external parasites, sore mouth, or abscesses.** Any abscess site must be healed and haired over.

Check-in and Arrival Time: We will begin checking in goats at **12:00 (Noon) on Friday June 22, 2012.** After unloading your animals please report to the Show Secretary with your papers to get checked-in. If you are going to be late arriving (after 9:00p.m.) please give us a call 208-420-2288, so we can make sure to be there to help you. Goat arrivals accepted until 8 am Saturday and Sunday.

Awards: The IBGA will provide Ribbons and Rosettes for both shows. Ribbons through fifth place, Rosettes for Grand and Reserve Champions will be awarded. Special Awards for overall grand and featured aged doe classes.

Entries: Fees must accompany entries. The early deadline is **June 8, 2012** (postmark). Entries and/or substitutions can be made up until start of show. However, entries postmarked after **June 8, 2012** will not be included in the show program and will have to pay the late entry fee. Note: Substitutions are allowed, but no refunds. Fees:

Early Deadline: June 8, 2012 – Fee is \$7.50 per head, per show.

Showmanship and meat/market classes Fees: \$5.00 per entry.

Late Entries: Postmarked after **June 8, 2012**- Fee is \$10.00 per head, per show.

Judging Clinic: Adult \$20.00 (**Postmarked after June 8, 2012 \$25.00**). 4H/FAA \$10.00 (**no late fees apply to 4H/FAA**)

Showmanship/Market Classes: There will be Showmanship and Youth Jackpot Market classes at \$5.00 per entry on Saturday. For Showmanship, the animal used may be any type or age and does not need to be registered. (Youth: 19 years and younger, adult: over the age of 19). Showmanship and Market classes will be determined at time of show based on Showmanship age and Market weights. Market animals will be weighed starting at 8:00 am and assigned to classes on the day of the show. Jackpot Market is for youth only. There will be a regular open Market class following the youth Jackpot Market Classes. Fee for open Market class is \$5.00 per entry.

Judging Clinic: There will be a judging clinic held after the Show on Saturday, June 23. The fee for this clinic is \$20.00 per person, 4H/FAA fee will be \$10.00. Early deadline is June 8, 2012 (postmark). Entries received after June 8 will be charged a \$25.00 fee for adults and there will be no late fee for 4H/FAA participants.

Pen Fees: \$6.50 per pen and \$4.00 for 4H/FAA exhibitors (1 to 4 animals per pen depending on size and age) and tack pens will be available. Additional pens needed at check-in may be separated from other pens. All pens will be assigned prior on check-in date. Pens will be supplied with bedding (straw). **All pens must be cleaned prior to your departure. A \$10.00 cleaning deposit will be charged each exhibitor and will be refunded when pens are cleaned. The deposit will be used to defray costs of cleaning any uncleaned pens.**

Camping – Hook-ups available on the grounds at \$20.00 per night and \$10.00 dry sites per night, please note the number of nights needed on entry form.
