The Jackpot will consist of Market, Breeding and Showmanship classes.

General Rules:

1. The jackpot is open to any youth 4-21 years old by January 1st.
2. You **do not** need to be a member of any association or club to show in the Jackpot.
3. There will be no maximum number of entries per exhibitor.
4. All goats must have permanent identification, either in the form of a tattoo or official scrapie tag.
5. Goats shall be healthy and free of any visible diseases.
6. The same goat may not be shown in both Market and Breeding classes.
7. Classes with 4 or less entries will be combined with the next class. Classes with more than 10 entries will be divided and 1st and 2nd place winners in each split will be judged in a run off.

Jackpot Market Classes:

1. All market animals will be required to have milk teeth in normal position.
2. Market classes are open to both wethers and does.
3. Market animals must be disbudded
4. Wether goats must be castrated prior to arriving on the show grounds.
5. Market animals will be shown by weight. Classes will be generated after weigh-in and distributed evenly.

Jackpot Breeding Classes:

1. Percentage and Purebred/Fullblood does only, no bucks.
2. Does will be shown by age (0-3 months, 4-6 months, 7-9 month, 10-12 months and 12 to 18 months) Class sizes may be combined or split depending on number of entries.
3. Does need not be registered to show, but birthdate is required.
4. Animals in the breeding classes are not required to be disbudded. Horn tipping is allowed.
5. Judging will be done by ABGA certified judges, therefore ABGA breed standards will apply.

Bred & Owned Class

1. There will be a Bred and Owned Class for breeding does that were bred and are currently owned by the youth showing them.
2. Exhibitors are limited to one (1) doe. No bucks or wethers
3. Registration papers or proof of ownership is required.

Showmanship:

1. Peewee – ages 8 and under & can handle their goat
2. Junior – ages 9-11
3. Intermediate – ages 12-15
4. Senior – ages 16-21

Class sizes may be modified depending on number of entries.

Check-in and Arrival Time: We will check in goats at 8 am to 9 am Saturday June 27, 2015. Please report to the Show Secretary to get checked in and weighed. **All breeding does must be checked in by 9 am. Market animals must be weighed in by 10:30 am.** The Jackpot will begin at 9 am with showmanship, followed by breeding does, bred & owned and market wethers.

Awards: SRMGA will provide Ribbons and Rosettes for the show. Ribbons will be awarded through fifth place, with rosettes for Grand and Reserve Champions. Cash Awards (Jackpot Money) will be given for Grand and Reserve Champions of each division. All exhibitors making it to the Championship drive will receive premium money.

Entries: Fees must accompany entries. **Entries will not be considered received unless accompanied with the entry fees.** The early deadline is **June 22, 2015.** (postmarked). Entries

after that date will be subject to a \$10 late fee. Substitutions can be made up until start of show. **Note: substitutions are allowed, but no refunds.**

Fees:

Early Deadline: June 23, 2015 – Fee is \$15.00 per goat for the Market, Breeding Doe and Bred & Owned classes. Fee is \$10.00 for Showmanship

Late Entries: Additional \$10 for entries postmarked or delivered after June 23, 2015.

Pens: Since this is a one morning show, there are no pens assigned for Jackpot goats. Jackpot entries will be able to use any pens left over after the open show pens have been assigned. If you must have pens, please include it on the entry form.

Camping: Please indicate on your entry form if you will need a camping space. Fees are \$15 per night with electricity, but no water.
